Delivers high-quality public & civil services, engenders trust & participation, demonstrates political stability, upholds rule of law

### Equitable distribution of resources

Ensures equity in access to resources such as education, health, technology, food & water

### Sound business environment

Strong economic conditions support the operation of a private sector which promotes economic productivity & healthy business competition

### High levels of integrity

Enhances confidence and trust in institutions so that resources are efficiently allocated to fund essential services

### Acceptance of the rights of others

Both formal laws that guarantee basic human rights & freedoms as well as informal social norms for the behavior of citizens



### Free flow of information

Free & independent media leads to greater openness and civil societies that work better together and make better decision & more rational responses in times of crisis

### Good relations with neighbors

Peaceful relations between communities and nations facilitate trade and reduce the need for military & policing expenditures

### High levels of human capital

Reflects how citizens are educated and how knowledge is developed, improves economic productivity & care for the young, and enables political participation
